Topic: Whatever you ask in Jesus name – Part 1

Bible Reading: John 14:12-14

Introduction

Asking is requesting someone to do something for you. In the Biblical context, asking in Jesus name, means presenting your requests before God through His Son Jesus Christ. Nowadays, not all the people who are petitioning God receive favorable responses, due to one reason or the other. However, the few worthy people always receive gracious and merciful responses; whenever they ask for anything that will not hurt them, or lead them astray from the righteous path.

The love of God answers our prayers

In the beginning, God demonstrated His unfailing love for humans by creating them in His image and likeness. He also gave them dominion over all His creation; so that they are in charge/control on earth, just as He is in control in heaven. The Bible corroborated this fact by saying, "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created Him; male and female He created them. Then God blessed them, and God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air and over every living thing that moves on the earth."" <u>Genesis 1:27-28.</u> If God loves mankind to the extent that He created them like Himself, don't you think He will do whatever we ask correctly? If God gave humanity authority to subjugate other creatures; do you think He will not answer any worth supplication? If not, God will do whatever you ask in Jesus name.

The undying love that God has for mankind made Him to send His Son Jesus Christ to come for the Salvation of the sinners; according

to the Book of John which says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16. The Salvation brought by Jesus Christ, made him to give us an open check that whatever we ask Him rightly will be done. Jesus gave the assurance that anything we ask our heavenly Father in His name will be done. Jesus Christ will do whatever that you ask Him, in a correct manner to do; according to the scripture which says, "If you ask anything in My name, I will do it." John 14:14. What are you waiting for? Are you ready to use Jesus' name to implore God regarding your issues? Today, entreat God in the name of Christ concerning your pressing needs. Do not delay; because tomorrow might be too late.

Jesus has given you an open check: You have an open check from our Lord Jesus Christ to ask whatever you want, and you will receive it. Do not bargain with God; be direct: ask for what you need, and it will be given to you. You must not misuse this grace; instead, keep on asking for your issues to be resolved, and you will receive a favorable response that will transform your life. So, what are you waiting for? Ask from God today, things that will make you live a peaceful and fulfilled life; according to the Bible passage which says, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you." Matthew 7:7, Luke 11:9. The Lord is waiting for you to present your prayer requests before Him. Unless you are satisfied with your situation; you need to ask quickly for all your needs. Write whatever amount in the spiritual open check given to you; because God is abundantly able to provide the amount. We pray that God will open spiritual doors of opportunity for you, in Jesus name.

Remember that it is your duty to ask; if you want the Lord to respond. If you keep mute, you are denying yourself the opportunity to have a rest of mind. Satan will be rejoicing

whenever you keep silent; because he will have the advantage of derailing your Christianity journey, and make your life unbearable. It is your right to ask for things that will make you comfortable from your heavenly Father; therefore, do not procrastinate, but ask today. Everyone who asks correctly will receive a merciful response from God; according to the Book of Luke which says, "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened." <u>Luke 11:10,</u> <u>Matthew 7:8.</u> Inasmuch as you have been authorized to ask; do not tarry, but ask now; so that God will give you relief from all your hardships.

Till now many are yet to ask: Nowadays numerous people are yet to utilize the name of Christ to ask for things from God. It is either they do not believe in the power and authority of Jesus Christ; or they are not aware of this opportunity. If you want your joy to overflow; do not delay, but ask whatever that is in compliance with the statutes of God; and it will be done for you. Is lack of knowledge preventing you from asking anything from God? Even though God has good plans for you, it is your responsibility to ask in the name of Jesus Christ; and God will certainly give it to you. The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full." John 16:24. For your difficulties to turn to history; pray to God using the name of Jesus Christ. If you want your joy to be complete; do not hesitate to ask whatever you want from God using the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We pray that your life will not remain the same, in Jesus name.

<u>Be in agreement concerning your common goals:</u> Asking in Jesus name is not restricted/limited to a single person; so, when two or more people have a common goal, and they ask in the name of Jesus Christ; it will be done. If the congregation of a church harmonizes together about anything they ask; it will

come to pass. Whenever the Believers are of one mind, and they pray using the name of Jesus; whatever they ask will receive a favorable response from the Lord. Do you always pray alone, or in agreement with other people? When was the last time that your church had a congregational prayer? Do you know that it is guaranteed that our heavenly Father will accept the prayers of two or more people if they agree? The Bible confirmed this fact by saying "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven." <u>Matthew 18:19.</u>

Today, many people do not go to church; because they think that it is a waste of time. Countless people do not attend church services; due to the demands of their careers. These people should realize that if they avoid attending church meetings and worshipping with congregation; then whatever they ask may not be done. This is a wake up call for Christendom. For this reason, do not neglect the assembly of the Beloved, if you want your prayers to be answered. Do not stay away from the church meetings and services; if you want to grow spiritually. Whoever wants his/her prayers to be answered, will not forsake the coming together of the Believers for worship and instruction but promote them. Be warned, it is not beneficial for anyone to hold aloof from the church meetings; as it is written. "Not forsaking the assembly of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." Hebrews 10:25. Never forget that congregational prayers are important for your petitions to be answered.

Topic: Whatever you ask in Jesus name – Part 2

Bible Reading: John 14:12-14

Jesus will do whatever you ask

Jesus Christ will do whatever you ask in the right manner. God will never deny you whatever that you request in the name of His only begotten Son. So, entreat the Lord today and your life will be transformed. Inasmuch as no sane parent, if his/her child asks for bread will give the hungry child sawdust; or if he/she asks for fish, will give such a child snake. If you humans who are wicked and sinful by nature know how to give good and advantageous gifts to your children; how much more will your heavenly Father who is perfect give good and spiritual gifts to those who ask Him in the name of Jesus Christ. Therefore, God will do anything that you ask using the mighty name of His Son. The scripture corroborated this fact in the following Bible passages: Matthew 7:9-11, Luke11:11-13. If humans are decent to their children, don't you think God will be better? Don't you think that God will give you a favorable response concerning whatever you ask correctly in Jesus name? Pray to God now; if you want superior and finest things.

Your prayers will be answered if: Your prayers will be answered if you believe in Jesus Christ. You will receive everything you asked for in prayer, provided you believe in Christ. If you believe, anything you ask rightly in prayer will be done; as long as it will neither hurt you nor lead you astray; according to the Book of Matthew which says, "And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive." <u>Matthew 21:22.</u> Today, pray for your

heart desires using Jesus' name, and have faith, and you will receive it.

Martha believed and pleaded with Jesus Christ and her brother Lazarus who died came back to life. If you too believe in Jesus and make a passionate plea; your issues will be resolved without delay. The ball is in your court; so make a move that will impact our life positively by begging the Lord from a believing heart. The Book of John chronicled the story of Lazarus by saying, "Now Martha said to Jesus, 'Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You.'" John 11:21-22. Do you have unshaken faith in the name of Jesus? Ask from a faithful heart, and the problems that are giving you sleepless nights will turn to history. We pray that the power that resides in the name of Christ will revive whatever that is spiritually dead in your life. Amen.

Hence, if you believe; you will have breakthrough concerning all your endeavors, and your life will not remain the same; in Jesus name. Inasmuch as all things are possible for anyone who believes; you will accomplish all your goals with ease, and you will thrive throughout your existence; according to the response of Jesus to the father of the child with a mute spirit; which says, "Jesus said to him, 'If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes." <u>Mark 9:23.</u> Do not doubt, but ask with faith; and God will make you successful. You will excel everywhere under the sky if you believe in Jesus Christ. Remember that faithfulness is necessary for God to fulfill His promises in your life and straighten your spiritual crooked path.

<u>God cannot lie:</u> Lie is rampant among mankind; it is widespread everywhere under the sky. It is hard, or rare to find anyone that is not telling lies, or acting deceptively among humans. The situation is so bad to the extent that Christian leaders are not standing in the truth; the head of government or rulers are using

lies to suppress the truth; and there is no truth in the dignitaries. Falsehood is like a second nature to countless people across the globe, and half-truths are flourishing among the Christendom. Satan has filled the world with lies and deception in a manner that is misleading the Beloved and making the Believers to stray on a daily basis.

Inasmuch as God is not a human being; so He cannot lie. God is not a mortal that He should be sorry for what He has said. God is not a man that He should tell or act a lie. He is not the son of man that He should feel repentance, or compunction for what He has promised. God will never make a promise without fulfilling it; instead He always fulfills His promises; according to the Bible passage which says, "God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?" <u>Numbers 23:19.</u>

If God always fulfills His promises, then every word of God will not return without producing any effect; instead it will accomplish what pleases God, and succeed in the matter for which it is sent. The word of God will not return useless, or empty; but it will achieve the purpose of God. Since the word of God is powerful, it will do the work God sent it to do; and it will complete the assignment given to it. As it is written, "So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it." Isaiah 55:11. Since God cannot lie, do you believe that His promises will be fulfilled in your life? Do you know that the word of the Lord will accomplish His plan in your journey? We pray that every word that God has spoken into your life for good will accomplish its aim and prosper; in Jesus name. Whether Satan likes it or not the promise of God will come to pass without delay in your life. Amen.

<u>The promises of God are Yes:</u> Jesus Christ alone can make the promises of God to be fulfilled in your life. The answer to all the

promises of God can be found in Jesus Christ our Savior. The yes to all God's promises is in Christ, and whatever God has promised gets stamped with the 'yes' of Jesus. Are you ready to ask in Jesus' name; so that God will answer? If you refuse, or fail to ask using the name of Jesus, you may not receive a favorable answer; because it is Christ who is the affirmative response to all of God's promises. This is why our Amen is said to the glory of God; according to the scripture which says, "For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us." <u>2 Corinthians 1:20</u>. Do not forget that all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding 'Yes!' So, pray to God today with the name of Jesus; and the story of your life will change positively.

The name of Jesus Christ alone can make things happen; so, do not joke with this powerful name; because Jesus will grant whatever you ask in His name. Inasmuch as Christ wants His Father to be glorified and extolled through Him; He will do anything you ask in His name. Ask Jesus, and He will do everything you ask; in order to bring honor to His Father. If you ask for anything in Jesus name; it will be done; according to the Book of John which says, "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son." John 14:13. It is time to make your prayer request using the name of Jesus. Ask God using Jesus' name for your life to be settled, and you will witness great changes in your journey. Be assured that if you ask anything using the name of Jesus; it will be granted without delay.

Topic: Whatever you ask in Jesus name – Part 3

Bible Reading: John 14:12-14

Obedience is required for answering your prayers

You must comply with the commands of the Lord, whenever you are using the name of Jesus to ask things from God; before your prayer requests can be granted. Obedience and asking in the name of Jesus will give you a favorable response from God; which means pleasing the Lord and pleading with Christ's name will give you a good answer from God. Though, God is mighty; but He does not despise anyone, instead He will repay everyone according to their deeds. God will never reject any obedient person; but respond quickly to the petition of such a person. God does not hate anyone; that is the reason that the rain falls on the righteous and wicked people; however, the supplication of the disobedient people is an abomination to God.

Though, God cares about everyone, and He does not regard anyone as trivial, but makes fair decisions. It is better to be obedient; since you cannot deceive God; because there is nothing He doesn't understand and He knows your motives. So, God never takes His eyes off the righteous, but honors them lavishly and promotes them endlessly. Therefore, obey the commands of God and keep His statutes; so that He will answer whenever you ask in Jesus' name; according to the scripture which

says, "Behold God is mighty, but despises no one; He is mighty in strength of understanding." Job 36:5. Inasmuch as God is firm in His intent, why not obey Him?

It is compulsory to obey God: Whether it is pleasant or unpleasant, you must listen to and honor the voice of God; so that it will be well with you in the land of the living. Even if it isn't what you want to do; it is inevitable for you to obey God, in order to be successful. It does not matter if you like His commands or not; it is your duty to obey God to whom you are using Jesus' name to pray; so that you will receive a gracious reply; according to the Book of Jeremiah which says, "Whether it is pleasing or displeasing we will obey the voice of the Lord our God to whom we send you that it may be well with us when we obey the voice of the Lord our God." Jeremiah 42:6. Whether the statutes of the Lord are favorable or unfavorable, will you still obey Him? Are you ready to do everything that God commands without complaints? Do you know that obedience is what will make your prayers to be answered? Always obey the Lord, and never oppose or query His commands.

<u>Obedience fulfills the promises of God:</u> The promise of God to our father Abraham was fulfilled; because of His obedience. God fulfilled His promise to our ancestor Abraham, when Jesus Christ the Seed of Abraham came to this world; all the nations of this world were blessed in Him, and through Christ the nations bless themselves because Abraham obeyed the order of God. The Book of Genesis attested to this fact by saying, "In your seed all the nations of earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." <u>Genesis 22:18.</u> Considering the usefulness of obedience in the passage, you too must be obedient in all your ways. You must obey God, even when using Jesus' name to ask, in order to receive a good response from God. Since obedience is effective, are you ready to obey the commands or the voice of God? If you want to achieve your just goals in this world, be obedient.

All the blessings mentioned in the Holy Bible will be yours in abundance if you obey God. If you obey God, He will make you famous on earth, and bless you in many ways. You must obey God and faithfully keep all His commands; before God will make you a dignitary and important figure in the world. The Bible chronicled this fact by saying, "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God." <u>Deuteronomy 28:1-2.</u> Since obedience and asking in Jesus' name go hand in hand; are you ready to obey God in every situation? We pray that the blessing of the Lord will not depart from you. Amen.

The promise of God is conditional: The promise of God is conditional, and you must satisfy the terms of the condition/s; before it will be fulfilled. The promise of God is like a bilateral agreement that you have to carry out your own part of the agreement; before God will fulfill His own part. Therefore, if you obey God; whatever you ask in Jesus' name will be done. If you faithfully obey God, He will be a fierce enemy of your enemies. God will fight all who fight against you; and He will defend you in an incomprehensible way. The only thing that will make God to oppose those who oppose you is obedience; according to the Bible passage which says, "But if you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries." Exodus 23:22. So, you have to be obedient, before God will be a foe of your foes, and fulfill His promises in your life; by giving you whatever you ask in Jesus name.

If you obey and serve God; you will be successful and happy during your lifetime. If you want to spend your days in

prosperity, and your years in pleasantness, be obedient. Obedience will make you live in peace, joy, and contentment throughout your existence; according to the Book of Job which says, "If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasure." Job 36:11. Be obedient, if you want to live a comfortable life.

Obedience is beneficial: Obedience is beneficial and profitable in every way; most especially when combined with asking in Jesus' name. Some of the benefits are the following:

- If you listen obediently and pay attention to the commandments of God. He will send rain at the right seasons and whenever it is needed; so that there will be no drought, and no food shortage; instead you will have more than enough food, wine and other necessary things to satisfy your needs. **Deuteronomy 11:13-15.**
- If you are obedient, God will make you successful in everything you do, and make you abundantly prosperous in every work of your hand. God will make you exceedingly fertile during your lifetime, and He will bless your livestock together with the produce of your land. God will be delighted in giving you abundance and enjoy doing good things for you. God will be glad to make you prosperous, and He will be pleased to make you happy. <u>Deuteronomy 30:9-10.</u>
- If you obey the commands of God, poverty will be eradicated from your journey; and you will have sufficient to cater for your needs. God will make you a lender and not a borrower; you will be successful and rule over or have control over many people.
 <u>Deuteronomy 15:5-6.</u>
- If you faithfully obey God; you will be His peculiar treasure and be among His people. You will be the special possession of God and be among His chosen people. **Exodus 19:5.**

Topic: Whatever you ask in Jesus name – Part 4

Bible Reading: John 14:12-14

Your prayers will be answered if you are worthy

Though our God is a faithful God, and He will never fail to keep His promises; however, you must be worthy before God will fulfill whatever you ask in Jesus name. You must discharge your duties and merit your calling before God will answer your prayers. Inasmuch as God will give you what you deserve; be virtuous; so that God will give you a favorable response, whenever you present your prayer requests before Him.

Since you cannot carry on practicing sin as a habit, and expect the favor of God to multiply in your journey. If you want the promises of God to come to pass in your life; reject Satan and depart from sin. Whoever remains in sin must realize that the mercy of God cannot overflow in his/her life. Considering the fact that no human can exploit the grace of God; stop sinning so that God will give you whatever you ask using Jesus' name; according to the Book of Romans which says, "What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?" <u>Romans 6:1.</u> Are you ready to quit your sinful and lustful lifestyle; so that the promises of God will be fulfilled in your journey? Change today

before it is too late.

Christians must realize that God has been more generous to them among mankind; so He expects them to serve him better and faithfully. Therefore, much is required from the person to whom much is given. For this reason, purity and worthiness are required from the Christians that God bestowed great spiritual gifts; because great gifts means great responsibilities; according to the scripture which says, "...For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more." <u>Luke 12:48.</u> We can deduce from the passage that you must fulfill your obligations to the Lord; before His pending promises will come to pass in your life.

<u>Please God, abide in Christ and bear fruit:</u> It is inevitable to be satisfactory to God; in order to receive a good response to your supplications. You must please God, if you want Him to do whatever you ask in Jesus name; however, without faith no one can please God. You must believe that God is real, and He rewards the worthy people who search for Him; before He will fulfill His promises in your life. Remember that Enoch was promoted to the eternal world without experiencing death; because he pleased God. So, trust in the Lord God to please Him; according to the Bible passage which says, "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." <u>Hebrews 11:6.</u> Do not forget that pleasing God will give you a favorable answer.

If you are vitally united with Christ, and His messages live in your heart; then whatever you ask will be done. The best way for your prayers to be answered is to stay joined to Jesus, and allow His teachings to become part of you. Ask anything you want and it will be given to you; if you abide in Christ and follow His

teachings. The Bible corroborated this fact by saying, "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire and it shall be done for you" John 15:7. You must remain joined to the Lord, and permit His words to dwell richly in your heart; if you want whatever you ask to be granted.

You must be fruitful and produce lasting fruits; before you will be granted whatever you ask. The only way for you to be given anything you ask is to bring forth lasting fruit. The sole purpose that Christ appointed the Christians is to produce fruit that abides. The Book of John testified to this fact by saying, "You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you." John 15:16. Do you know that you are in the world to bear fruit for the Lord? Are you fruitful or fruitless? Do you think the fruit you produce will last or spoil? Do you know that everything you ask will be done; if you are a fruit bearer? Do not forget that you must live in Christ and please God; before your prayers can be answered.

Promise of God will not be postponed: Humans must realize that whatever that is humanly impossible to achieve will be easily achieved by God. We need to know that God can do anything that humans cannot do. Every feat that people think is inconceivable is a child's play before God. Therefore, no matter what you are passing through; just use the name of Jesus to ask and you will receive, if you are worthy; according to the Book of Matthew which says, "But Jesus looked at them and said to them, 'With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.'" <u>Matthew 19:26.</u>

Even if your situation is humanly impossible to resolve, God will rectify and settle it; if you ask in Jesus name. Inasmuch as everything is possible for God to accomplish, and no word from God is without fulfillment power. Your own case will be resolved

today; if you ask with faith. God can do anything, and nothing is impossible for God; according to the scripture which says, "For with God nothing will be impossible <u>Luke 1:37</u>. Since no promise of God can fail to be fulfilled; unless people are not faithful; we pray that the pending promises of God will come to pass in your life without delay, in Jesus name. Every word that God has uttered into your life will not return void; instead they will achieve their intended purpose, in Jesus name.

Delay is not denial: If the promise of God is yet to be fulfilled in your life; it does not mean that it is denied; because delay is not denial. If whatever you ask in Jesus name tarries; just wait upon the Lord and it will be done for you; as long as you are obedient and worthy. The promise of God for you will hurries toward the goal of fulfillment, and it will not fail; if you abide in Jesus Christ. Sometimes the promise may be delayed, but wait patiently for it; because it will certainly be fulfilled. Whenever you experience any delay concerning anything you ask; examine yourself, to know if you are in right standing before God. If you are righteous; wait for it, even if it takes a long time; because it will surely happen.

God knows what is best for you and God's time is the best. Even though your prayer requests may linger; but that does not mean it will not be granted; it may seem like a long time; but be patient and wait for them to be fulfilled in God's time. Inasmuch as God always makes everything beautiful in His time; anything you ask may seem slow in coming to pass, but wait for it; it will definitely take place and it will not be delayed more than the necessary time for God to perfect your issue. You need to take note that the promise of God aches for coming to pass in your life; it can hardly wait; however, if it tarries, wait, because it is on its way; and it will come right on time.

The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "For the vision is yet for an

appointed time; but at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it because; it will surely come and will not tarry." <u>Habakkuk 2:3.</u> Every vision, word and promise of God will be fulfilled in your life. Inasmuch as delay is not denial; if it seems slow in coming to pass, wait patiently; because it will surely happen when you least expect without any unnecessary delay; in Jesus name. The angel that God will use to perfect your issues will come on time and will not be late. Amen. The benefactors appointed by God to lift you up in life will come to your aid without delay; in Jesus name. The people that God will use to resolve your problems and transform your life will show up any minute; and you will forget your miseries, in Jesus name. Amen.

Topic: Whatever you ask in Jesus name – Part 5

Bible Reading: John 14:12-14

Let the will of God be done in your life

The intention of God toward mankind is great, and it is the best thing that can happen in anyone's life. The desire of God for humanity is that of life and peace. Well-being is the decision of God for those who are upright. Therefore, whenever you are asking for anything in Jesus name; make sure that you add 'Let Your will be done.' Inasmuch as the will of God for you is the best plan to succeed in this world; then make sure that the purpose of God is fulfilled in your journey.

It should be noted that God knows your needs and He is prepared to satisfy those needs; if you do things that pleases Him. If God feeds the birds, don't you think He will feed you? If God clothes the flowers, don't you think He will cover your nakedness? So, stop worrying yourself and allow the will of God to be fulfilled in your life; according to the scripture which says, "...If the God clothes the

grass, which today is in the field and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will He clothe you, O you of little faith?" <u>Luke</u> <u>12:22-28</u>. Though it is good to ask anything you want in Jesus name; however, what God predetermined for you is the best. Whatever God preordain for you is what will make you survive in this sinful world and inherit the heavenly kingdom of God.

You must do the will of God if: Anyone who wants the will of God to be done in his or her life must first do the will of God. It is when you do the will of God that God Himself will reciprocate this gesture by allowing His will to be satisfied in your life. For this reason. Christians must strive to do the will of God; so that they will abide forever in the kingdom of heaven. Inasmuch as this world and its shameful pursuits, together with its ungodly longings will pass away; why not do the purposes of God and live eternally? Do you know that if you abstain from the forbidden cravings and do the will of God, you will endure perpetually? The Book of John testified to this fact by saying, "And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever." 1 John 2:17. You must do what God wants in order to be set for eternity. If you don't want to be isolated from your Creator, but live forever, you must do the will of God at all times.

You must be separated and set apart from sin before you can proclaim to do the will of God. If you want to do the will of God, you must dedicate your life to your Maker, and abstain from sexual immorality. Shrinking from all sexual vice and keeping yourself holy is doing the will of God; according to the Bible passage which says, "For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexually immorality." <u>1 Thessalonians</u> <u>4:3.</u> It is clear from the passage that abstinence from sexual promiscuity and purity is required to do the will of God.

It is also necessary for you to be thankful to God in every

situation; whether good, or bad. No matter what the circumstance may be; it is your duty to give thanks to God. The will of God is for you to keep thanking your Creator for what He has done in your life, and what He is presently doing, and what He will do for you in the future. As it is written, "In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." <u>1</u> <u>Thessalonians 5:18.</u> Do you know that the will of God is for you to give thanks in whatever happens to you? Therefore, be thankful to God, if you want your issues to be resolved. The will of God is to do what is right and live honestly; in order to silence the ignorant charges and ill-informed criticism of the foolish people. You can stop and cure the ignorance of the fools who think you're a danger to society by doing the will of God; so that His promises will be fulfilled in your life.

<u>The will of God is indispensable:</u> The necessity of the will of God made Christ to give Himself up to atone for our sins; in order to rescue us from this present wicked age. Jesus came to this world to save and sanctify mankind from the world order; according to the purpose of God. Are you ready to obey God; so that His plan will be established in your life? If Jesus obeyed His Father, don't you think you too must be obedient? The time has come for you to permit the will of God to be done in your life; so that His glory will manifest in your journey. The Book of Galatians chronicles this fact by saying, "Who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father." <u>Galatians 1:4.</u> The will of God alone can rescue and set you free from this evil and sinful world.

It is for this reason that Jesus Christ taught us to mention that the will of God should be done; whenever we pray to God. The importance of the will of God was demonstrated when Jesus Christ mentioned it in the Lord's prayer. The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is

in heaven." <u>Matthew 6:10, Luke 11:2.</u> If the heavenly beings are doing the will of God; don't you think you must allow the will of God to be done in your life?

Ask for the will of God: Anytime that you are praying to God using Jesus' name; tell God to permit His will to be done in your life; instead of what you ask. If God desires to give you ten things and you only ask for one; that is what you will receive. God may have the intention of making you a billionaire and if you ask Him just for thousands; He will give you what you ask. Hence, always mention in your prayer that God should allow His purpose to be fulfilled in your life. You never know what God has in stock for you; so either you can comprehend or not, just tell your Maker to permit His plan to be established in your journey.

Jesus Christ was privy about his fact, and His prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane demonstrated that the will of God is better than the desires or prayers of humans. Christ made His prayer request to His Father that if it is consistent with the will of His Father; He should allow the cup of suffering to pass away from Him; according to the Book of Matthew which says, "He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed saying, 'O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will" Matthew 26:39. Jesus indicated in His prayer request; that not what He wanted, but what God wanted should be done. Are you ready to follow the footsteps of Christ, by allowing the will of God to be done in your life? Do you know that your prayer requests cannot be compared with the plan that God has for you? The necessity of the will of God made Jesus Christ to repeat His prayer request by saying, "O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me unless I drink it, Your will be done." Matthew <u>26:42.</u> Never forget to tell God to let His will be done in your life; whenever you ask anything in Jesus name from Him. We pray that you will receive whatever you ask today; in Jesus name.
