**Topic: Stop blaming God - Part 4** 

Bible Reading: Jeremiah 5:20-25

## Improve your relationship with God

People need to realize that it is inevitable for anyone who intends to inherit the kingdom of heaven to improve his/her relationship with God; then, humans must stop complaining, and enhance their connection with their Maker. Those who are complaining and blaming God must know that they are in a precarious situation because they have abandoned God. When the people who are in a discontented situation ask the question, 'Why did the Lord God do terrible things to us?' Then you will answer them that it is because they have forsaken God the fountain of life. Today, many have turned away from God and they are serving idols.

Are you among those who left God to serve deities? Do you reject God and surrender your soul for Satan? The Bible attested to this fact by saying, "And it will be when you say, 'Why does the LORD our God do all these things to us?' then you shall answer them, 'Just as you have forsaken Me and served foreign gods in your land, so you shall serve aliens in a land that is not yours.'" <a href="Jeremiah 5:19">Jeremiah 5:19</a>. Though some people may claim that they are not idol worshippers, which is true; but their nefarious activities are abominations in the presence of God. It is the vices of such people that put them in their dissatisfied conditions; because they are transgressors. Therefore, whether you are an idolater, or not; once you violate any of the commands of the Lord; you are liable for your discontented situation.

Are you among those twisting the words of God to defraud people? Are you telling alternative truths to take advantage of others? Is your life ruled by greed? The Bible confirmed this fact by saying, "Because from the least of them even to the greatest of them, everyone is given to covetousness; And from the prophet even to the priest, everyone deals falsely." **Jeremiah 6:13**. Do not forget that people who act falsely, and those who are deceptive should blame themselves not God; if they are not ready to improve their bond with their Creator.
